Key to providing mobility is establishing a robust and reliable wireless network capable of servicing hundreds of devices while guaranteeing rapid response time and safeguarding sensitive data from loss or theft.

The first wireless solution implemented by Bedminster Township Public School failed to satisfy the school's needs. The solution was slow, adversely affecting student and staff productivity, and failed to integrate wireless and switching services into one readily manageable package.

As a result, Bedminster Township Public School engaged **PBG Networks** to design and deliver a solution that featured high performance wireless access; single-pane-of-glass style management flexibility; sufficient scalability to accommodate future mobility demands; and low, predictable maintenance costs.

Bedminster School Achieves Mobility Goals

The Extreme Networks wireless network effectively replaced the existing Bedminster Township Public School network, realizing the performance and cost objectives set by the school and facilitating wireless access and security. A radius server and Microsoft Active Directory were employed to regulate handheld devices, and Microsoft Active Directory was invoked to control laptop security.
